

INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL – EUROPEAN MODEL COMPANY ACT

European Model Company Act

Over the last eight years academics and practitioners from more than twenty European countries have worked on a free-standing general model corporation statute – the European Model Company Act. The EMCA is inspired by the US-American Model Business Corporation Act, which has been adopted as a corporation statute by numerous US-states.

The EMCA offers a model company law to the EU member states or other interested countries. Countries are free to adopt it entirely or in part. The Summer School will provide students from inside and outside the EU with an overview of the EMCA and offer them the possibility to discuss the Model Act with international experts who drafted the EMCA. The Summer School is also part of the regular programme of the "Krakauer Rechtsforum", combining researchers from Austria, Germany and Poland.







Course Programme

The EMCA Summer School welcomes a limited number of international students and Ph.D. students. The participants will be offered a 5-day programme, which will be held in English.

Members of the working group who drafted the EMCA will provide an insight into the project, its content and its objectives. Particular chapters of the act will be examined in greater detail. The students will have the opportunity to participate in workshops and are expected to contribute and present their own ideas. The EMCA Summer School thereby intends to encourage an international debate about the EMCA and its future.

Beside the course programme the participants can enjoy guided tours of Würzburg and its historical sights. There will be enough free time to explore the city and its surroundings.

Registration, Costs and Funding

Those wishing to participate at the EMCA Summer School are asked to apply per email no later than <u>30 June 2016 14 July 2016</u> (extended deadline). The application shall include a short letter of motivation (max. 2 pages) and a Curriculum Vitae.

Thanks to the support of *Universitätsbund Würzburg e.V.* the Summer School is free of charge. Travel and Living Expenses must be borne by the participants.

International students may apply for a scholarship amounting to €500. We are grateful to the *Walter Sigle Stiftung* (Stuttgart) for offering this funding opportunity.
